- CPS provided project manager (Ryan Alexander) to create a plan for playground, survey was given to parents, community, neighbors for priority areas
- What didn't make the cut for Phase One? Swing set, net climber, zipline, 2 half court basketball courts, hill in the field, track around the field
- \$2 million left to pay to complete the full project
 - o Paved play area \$435k
 - o Play Equipment Core \$1.175 million
 - o Track \$385k
- \$5,000 from the playground has been given to Ms. Smolen for garden on the Northside of the school
